How much do the classes cost?

\$ 125 per student until the first 25 seats of each allotted class is filled.

What number do families call to enroll?

Register online at www.princetonreview.com (under SAT and your zip code) on or after August 2nd (registration begins at noon). You may also call 800-2Review (800-273-8439) to register, on or after August 2nd. Seats are limited!

Who can enroll?

Only Juniors and Seniors enrolled in Fulton County High Schools can enroll in the program, and students may only enroll in classes at their school.
